## Purpose / How Works

ITSP	A SIP trunk to an ITSP replaces PSTN
FXO	(Port) Gateway trunk connection to PSTN; a telephone
FXS	Port for analog phone / fax, provides dial tone; a wall jack
DSP	Digital Format Conversion and to / from analog
CUCM Clustering	Static data replicated (1 way—publisher to 1-8 subscribers) Dynamic data divided (server "owns" a phone)
What happens when a CUCM publisher fails	"Locked Configuration" mode. No changes to DB (phones, routing plans). Features operate (including forwarding, etc) on subscribers, replicated sideways & up when publisher returns
How CUCM sends call to UC	UC is an extension; call is forwarded with original # in the signaling message so UC can use correct mailbox
LDAP	Central authentication or source for user imports
MWI	After a message is left, UC calls the MWI extension & CUCM lights it
Jabber	Softphone app with presence, IM, video voicemail & conferencing, directory, web conference.
Web Conference	IM chat program with topic "rooms" with a history that predates you joining.
VCS	Handles video calls to / from external devices we don't control
VCS Control	Self-contained, good if you don't also have CUCM
VCS Expressway	Firewall traversal for video calls
VCS Expressway Edge	Component in the DMZ, talks with "Core"
VCS Expressway Core	Component inside the firewall; talks with "Edge"
Telepresence Management Suite	Logistics management for videoconferencing facilities—Deployment planning, contact list, video conference scheduling, centralized aministration of video conferences, etc.
